#### Diriyah

From the heart of a green oasis filled with orchards, farms, and fruitful palms in the middle of an Arab desert on the banks of Wadi Hanifa, Historical Diriyah is located in the North West of Riyadh, 20 km away. It is where Imam Muhammad bin Saud laid down the foundations of rule of the first Saudi state, which resulted an unprecedented prosperity of human civilization in the region. Its impact extended for hundreds of years.



## 12:45 -13:00 PM Al Masmak Palace (Photo Stop)

The palace was constructed in the hijri 14th century during the reign of Imam Abdullah bin Faisal as his residence and the center of power and money. The palace is a strong fort against enemies with its solid high walls. It has only two entrances and small openings in the walls for gun barrels at the time of battles. Today, the palace stands as a symbol of the history of regaining power and rule of the country displaying in its corridors the features of that era and its leaders after it had been turned into a museum in 1995/1416.

## 14:30 - 15:00 PM Sky Bridge at Kingdom Center

From a height of 300 meters in the sky of Riyadh, take in a stunning panoramic view of the beauty of the city through highly secure glass panels. These panels let you enjoy the view of the starry nights and contemplate the yellow lights reflected on the streets and buildings of Riyadh from the Sky Bridge. Another way to seize the moment is by taking selfies where the glamour of the city behind you on a clear day.

#### The Saudi National Museum

From the Earth to the moon, and from the prehistoric ages to the modern ages, the hallways of the Saudi National Museum will take you on an adventure that transcends time and space. You will witness artistic and historical evidence in the heart of Riyadh in Al Murabba neighborhood near King Abdulaziz palace. The museum was opened in 1419H and spans across a distance of 17,000Km2 where it tells the story of 3.700 artifacts such as statues. scripts and unique sculptures.

#### Al Murabba Historical Palace

The Murabba Palace was established by order of the late King Abdulaziz Al Saud, the founder of the kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The walls of Al Murabba Historial Palace are like a window to the rich history of Riyadh and a scene from its ancient memory. The 1680 m2 of land occupied by the palace overflows with the memories of the place, and the historical events it witnessed, along with the glory that was made on its land.

Edge of the World is the name of the 1.131 m height cliff that lies some 100 km from Riyadh at the end of the 800 km extending Tuwaik Mountain range. Edge of the World is the perfect destination of mountain climbing and hiking lovers. Discover the breathtaking off-cliff spectacular views.



## Al Najd Village Restaurant (19 PM onwards - 4 hrs approx)

You will experience the taste of Authentic traditional Saudi Cuisine at Al Najd Village Restaurant. Enjoy the most delicious Najd cuisine in a special atmosphere that reflects the heritage and life of the beautiful past, with sessions inspired by the ancient past of Najd at Najd Village restaurants.



## Boulevard Riyadh City (17 PM onwards - 5 hrs approx)

But while the date farms are an obvious stop on your Al Ahsa itinerary, here are some other sites you can't miss.



## 12:00-13:00 PM Dougha Handmade Pottery Factory

For generations, local potters have been crafting works at the Dougha Handmade Pottery Factory, one of the oldest of its kind in the region. Try your hand at creating something of your own at the wheel, or pick up a souvenir to take home

#### Al Qarah

Explore the network of caves that carve out snaking pathways flanked by soaring tawny walls, and pay a visit to the Land of Civilizations museum to learn about the area's millennia-old history.

Al Salem museum, was established by village residents themselves, with its vast collection of artefacts including elaborately embroidered clothing, jewelry and ceramics, as well as weapons and cooking utensils. Speak up if you have questions: friendly residents will happily explain their provenance and regale you with stories about Ushaiger and its history.



### 11:40 AM

#### Ushaiger Heritage Village

Hidden in the heart of the Najd, lies an enchanting oasis-dotted region 200 km northwest of Riyadh, Ushaiger Heritage Village provides a glimpse of a slow-paced Saudi society of old ways of life. Bedouins first settled here 1,500 years ago and the town quickly became a popular stopping point for pilgrims crossing to Makkah, thanks to its springs and low-brimmed olive and palm groves. Ushaiqer meaning 'little blonde' to reflect the nearby red mountain that looms over the yellow mud houses, still has a small community of residents, making use of its schools, shops and mosques. To walk its narrow lanes is to enter a living museum, draped with traces of an ancient way of life.

When you visit Jeddah, you will have the opportunity to witness a rich heritage celebrated by UNESCO. From "Historical Jeddah" to the antique designs of balconies, stone walkways and ancient sidewalks, this destination unearths secrets that have inspired artists, writers and visitors alike for hundreds of years. Here, you will have a chance to see magnificent sunsets shimmering off the divine Red Sea shores as well as having magical diving experiences featuring colorful coral reefs. Whether on land or under the sea, you won't soon forget Jeddah's many year-round splendors.







## JEDDAH FULL DAY TOUR 11/12 HRS - APPROX

#### 9:30-10:10 AM

### Al Tayebat International City

For a fascinating look into Jeddah's long and cosmopolitan past, take a trip to the Tayebat Museum for a superbly curated representation of the city's 2,500-year history. Located in the Al Faisaliyah district, the museum is housed in a multiroom complex that re-creates the traditional Hijazi architecture of the old city, with bay windows overlaid with intricate wooden lattice work and ornate coral masonry. With several floors of in-depth exhibits, the museum offers a living history lesson on the foundation of Jeddah, Saudi Arabia and the wider Arabian Peninsula. There is also an entire floor dedicated to the city's rich Islamic heritage.



## 10:45 -13:00 PM Al-Balad & Beit Nassif

Before naming it as the royal seaport for Makkah at 657 AD, the Al-Balad site, "Historic Jeddah", was built on beautiful coastal land. It gathered people from all cultures and walks of life throughout the ages. This part of the world unveils a human heritage whose walls challenged different historical factors with eight gates; each is known for their historical stories. In addition, it holds more than 10 ancient houses praised for their distinctive designs and the names of their ancient families. Here, you will get the coziest photographs.

A grand mansion that has been transformed into a museum that houses kitchen utensils, pottery and photographs from a bygone era. While the collection of atrefacts isn't all that extensive, the building itself, which is the former temporary home of King Abdul Aziz, is beautiful with intricate carvings on the facades, railings, pillars and ceilings.

## 14:30 — 15:30 PM Jeddah Sculpture Museum

This open-air museum houses 20 sculptures by the likes of Joan Miró and Henry Moore and date back to the 1970s when Jeddah invested heavily in art. There are some pretty cool installations from abstract bronze shapes to a depiction of a giant flame and each one represents something specific about Jeddah's heritage and culture. One of our favourites?



Maha Malluh's sculpture, Abraj, which is made of recreations of aluminum pots that came from various Saudi Arabian flea markets – a perfect example of one person's junk being another person's treasure.



## 16:00-16:30 PM Floating Mosque

The Floating Mosque was built in 1985 on a water surface, with bases planted under the surface of the sea. It is also called "Al-Rahmah mosque."

It is marked by its bright white color and its turquoise dome which paints a wonderful scene especially when the sun shines on it to reflect the beauty of architecture joined with Islamic and traditional constructive art. The beauty of the mosque is not limited to its construction, it is also equipped with advanced sound and lighting technologies, to complement the elements that distinguish it from others with serenity and extreme beauty.



## 16:50-17:30 PM Jeddah Corniche & King Fahd's Fountain

This is no doubt the place everybody adores, a place that instantly and seamlessly delights and revitalizes your heart. It is precisely where visitors fall deeply captive in Jeddah. Explore one of the latest waterfronts in the world.

Visible from all across the city, King Fahd Fountain is a much-loved Jeddah landmark, and a 30-year-old monument in the middle of the Red Sea. At 312 meters high, its waters decorate the sunset of Jeddah, and whether you are thinking of taking a picture or a video of that magical scene, seeing the fountain will not seem impossible no matter how far away you are. As the spectacular display of the fountain continues, you can walk around and try different kinds of food along the various stalls in Alhamra corniche. Seven is the most popular kiosk on the walkway.

#### 11:15-12:00 PM

#### Shubra Palace Musuem or Photo Stop

Step back in time through the doors of the Shubra Palace Museum, once the royal summer residence of King Abdul Aziz and, later, King Faisal. A stunning throwback to old Taif, the museum's architectural features include latticework windows and balconies, and pristine marble interiors.



### 12:15 -13:00 PM

#### Al-Balad Market

If Italians live in their piazzas, in Arabia, locals are found in their sougs. The Taif Soug, one of the largest in the country, sits in the heart of the beautifully renovated historic center and is a must-see market. Wander the stalls to find handicrafts, local honey and rose water and to sip on cup of refreshing mint tea.

#### Al Kaaki Palace

In the historical area of Taif, the exquisite architectural artistry of Al-Kaaki Palace combined juniper wood, granite stone, and colored glass to form and build the palace in the ancient Roman style, blended the spirit of the Hijaz community presented in the design of the palace windows and in the Hijazi decorations extending to the roof, forming an architectural masterpiece located on Al-Salama street.



#### 15:15 – 15:45 PM Rose Factory

One of the most beautiful exceptional experiences that you will have is a visit to the famous factories of Taif rose products to embark on a rich and unparalleled journey of exploration.



## 16:00-17:30 PM AL Hada Mountain

Al-Hada Mountain, one of the most famous mountains in Saudi Arabia. Al-Hada Mountain is one of Al-Sarawat Mountains range extending in a curved line of about 87 km between the two cities of Taif and Makkah.

Cable Car: It is one of the most exciting adventures among mountains at a height of 2.177 m above sea level, and 4.2 km from the peak of Al-Hada Mountains down Al-Kar Tourist Village in Al-No'man Valley. The high ride introduces you to the longest cable car journey in the Middle East and the fifth in the world.

## Old town Day tour

Get a glimpse into AlUla's not-so-distant past on the AlUla Old Town Tour. A Rawi (guide) will lead you through AlUla Old Town, where pilgrims, travellers and permanent settlers congregated through the ages. Inhabited from before the 12th century up until the early 1980s, AlUla Old Town offers researchers unique oral histories and living memory that the area's other heritage sites cannot.





### Oasis Heritage Trail 2 hrs

Take a stroll under towering date palms and smell the cool freshness of the earth. Stretching from the Heart of the oasis to the Alshaqary Trail, one of AlJadidah Trails, this beautiful, designated trail showcases the heritage of the AlUla Oasis. #### AlUla Stairway

#### 1 hrs (Closed-Mon & Tue)

Thrill seekers need to look no further than the AlUla Stairway, a magical mountain adventure set in the sky. The first of its kind in the region, the AlUla Stairway takes you up a 45m suspended ladder stairway with an exhilarating zipline back down to the valley floor, leaving you with an epic photo to take back home.



# Giant Swing 1 hrs (Closed-Mon & Tue)

The Giant Swing is just what the thrill seekers visiting AlUla have been waiting for. Set off on a 100m Via Ferrata climb up to the launch site for the newest adventure attraction in the Kingdom. A leap from a mountain's edge will result in a 70m swing, flying through canyon walls while taking in gorgeous vista views.



## Helicopter Ride 30 min (Closed-Mon & Tue)

Take to the skies to experience the breath-taking views of stunning desert vistas and iconic landmarks such as Elephant Rock and the World UNESCO site, Hegra. View the world from a new angle and make memories that will last a lifetime.



## The Adventure Trail

## 5/6 hrs (April to September- Thu & Fri)

The Adventure Trail is an 8 km long historical treasure site with clusters of pictographs that are two-thousand years old. This trail is the best representation of AlUla's rich heritage and beautiful nature. Experience a variety of different terrains including volcanic rocks and soft sand.

The Adventure Trail is a 1 hour 10 minute drive each way and the hike itself takes around 3-4 hours, depending on fitness levels. In Winter months, some sections of the trail will have deep pools of rainwater that reach up to the waist line or beyond. The tour will pass through the water pools so please bring a change of clothes with you.

## Rock Climbing 2 hrs (Wed, Fri & Sat)

Take adventure to the next level with rock climbing on the spectacular mountains of AlUla. Enjoy this fun adventure sport while taking in nature's beauty surrounding you.



## Via Ferrata & Canyon Hammock Experience

## 2 hrs (Closed-Monday & Tuesday)

Zigzag your way across the canyon, suspended in a harness, completing aerial challenges and manoeuvring through floating obstacles. Via Ferrata is a spectacular journey enabling non-climbers to experience the world of mountaineering!



# Abseil Experience 2 hrs (Thu & Sun)

Experience the thrilling adventure of abseiling down AlUla's magnificent mountain landscapes. Feel the adrenaline rush as you descend downward and embark on this outdoor journey of a lifetime.



## Hidden Valley of Al Ula 3 hrs -Daily (Minimum 4 pax)

Experience the magnificence and peace of the Arabian desert on this 4 km long hike. Spanning over roughly 1.5 hours this trip through soft beige sands will transport you to simpler times as you immerse yourself in nature and admire the rock formations and landscapes of AlUla.

The start of the trail is a 45 minute drive from Husaak Center AlUla.

## Al Ula Zipline Experience 1 hr (Wed, Fri & Sat)

Experience the Kingdom's most thrilling zipline, racing a total of 1.5km at up to 120 km/h speed while enjoying the incredible scenery of the AlUla mountains. This year we've added an extension, making this dual zipline the longest and fastest of its kind in KSA.



#### Madakhel Canyon

### 8 hrs -Daily (Minimum 4 pax)

This is a shorter version of The Twisted Maze; you will go through the narrow canyon. Wet or dry, we don't stop, it has a different flavour each time. The challenge level is high but lots of fun climbing through the narrow canyon walls.

The start point is a 1 hour drive each way. In Winter months, some sections of the canyon will have deep pools of rainwater that reach up to the waistline or above. The group may have to pass through the water pools so please bring a change of clothes with you.



## Al Ula Grand Caynon Hike 8 hrs -Daily (Minimum 4 pax)

AlUla is known for archaeological remnants, amazing rock formations and interesting canyons. AlUla Grand Canyon is a 12 km hike through a vibrant canyon with colorful rocks, the rocks hold a variety of minerals. The hike is considered a medium level but towards the end it becomes more challenging with steep sections and bouldering. This is an adventure, you will walk on exposed edges and navigate ladders. Not suitable for htose with a fear of heights and receded for those in good fitness.

The start point is 1.5 hour drive each way and the hike will take around 4-5 hours depending on the speed of the group.

## The Ridge Walk Hike 4 hrs -Daily (Minimum 4 pax)

This easy 6 km hike along a ridge offers spectacular views of Wadi AlUla. Perfect for families and groups looking to see more of AlUla's expansive landscape. this hike is initially a steep uphill walk.

It later eases into a light walk allowing you to immerse yourself in the surrounding landscape and take in the beauty of AlUla.

The start point is a 30 minute drive from Husaak Center AlUla and the hike itself will take around 2.5 to 3 hours depending on the speed of the group. Sunset Tour - (April till September)/ Morning Tour (Oct to March)/ Afternoon Tour (Oct to March)



## Sharan Nature Tour Al Ula 9 hrs (Thu, Fri, Sat & Sun)

Experience some of AlUla's best rock formations on this Sharan Nature Tour. Sit back and relax in the comfort of an airconditioned vehicle as our local AlUla guide takes you on a 4x4 safari to Arch Rock, Madakel and Malab to see the striking sandstone canyons. From here the guide will return to AlUla town as they take you to visit the old down, AlUla viewpoint and Elephant Rock.

## Top of Al Harra Hike 4/5 hrs (Closed Thursday)

The start point is a 1 hour drive from Husaak Center AlUla. Begin with a 1.5 hour hike uphill walking on boulders big and small, you will use your hands some parts so gloves are useful. Spend 15 minutes at the top taking in the scenery before returning the same way. The descent will take around 1 hour, the group will take it slow as some of the rocks are loose. Watch out for slippery rocks, ankle support hiking boots are a must. This trip is not recommended for anyone with pre existing knee injuries should avoid this experience..

## TABUK

Tabuk, the capital city of the Tabuk region in northwestern Saudi Arabia, has long been a resting point for Jordanian and Egyptian pilgrims. Its rich culture can be felt in Souq Twaheen, famed for selling patterned rugs and goat-hair tent covers. Visitors flock to Tabuk to explore ancient archaeological sites and the setting of the story of the prophet Moses, who lived east of the city for a decade. Marking the start of the Saudi Coast, Tabuk's charming coastal towns, such as Haql and Sharma, offer clear seas and pristine beaches. But there are more terrains to explore: Consider checking out the carved tombs of Maghaer Shuaib in the desert, or the Moses Springs near Maqna, where natural springs flow under date palms. Or the stunning Tayeb Al Ism, a valley of steep granite stones separated from the turquoise-fringed Gulf of Aqaba by only the road.





## TABUK CITY TOUR 4/5 HRS - APPROX

#### Ottoman Hijazi Railway Remains

Located in Tabuk, Hijaz Railway Station was built almost a century ago to take Muslim pilgrims from Damascus to the holy cities of Makkah and Medina but ended in ruins less than two decades after its start. It has become a famous tourist attraction and also, declared as UNESCO world heritage site in Tabuk.



#### 9:40 - 10:10 AM Tabuk Castle

There are spectacular fortresses all around Tabuk, but this imposing castle in the center of town might be the oldest. It's known to date from 1559, though some claim there was a fortress here as early as 3500 B.C. Inside its walls, two mosques are linked by courtyards, stairwells and watchtowers, and there's a small museum detailing the history of the castle and the wider city — from the great explorers who visited, like Ibn Battuta, to the caravans of pilgrims who would stop to drink from its wells on their way to Makkah and Medina.



#### 10:20-10:30 AM

#### Al Tawba Mosque (Photo stop)

The Al Tawba Mosque is a mosque in Tabuk, that was also referred to as the Castle Mosque as it is located near the Tabuk Castle. Due to its link with the Battle of Tabuk, the mosque is considered a very important landmark in the Tabuk region. During the Prophet's Peace Be Upon Him (PBUH) stay at the mosque in the 7th century AD, it was also referred to as the Messenger's Mosque.



#### 11:00-12:00 PM

#### Farm Visit in Tabuk (Astra/Tadco)

Due to its abundance of water, mild climate and geological nature, the region is also known for its farms that grow various quality crops.

Tabuk is home to more than 14,500 farms that produce 1.58 million grape trees, 1.48 million peach and apricot trees, 1.3 million olive trees, 834,358 palm trees, 90,000 citrus trees,80,000 pomegranate trees and 58,000 mango trees. Wheat crops extend over an area of 19,000 hectares, vegetables crops extend over 50,000 hectares, and there are up to 9,850 greenhouses.

#### Magha'er Shuaib

Midian (Al bad) is the land where Moses spent 10 years in voluntary exile before returning and freeing his people from Pharaoh Ramses II. And the homeland of Jethro (Prophet Shuaib) who was Mose's Father in Law. The Mugha'yer Shuaib seems to appear from nowhere in the reddish desert west of Tabuk. Moses (as) lived here a decade under the patronage of the Prophet Shuaib, who had been impressed by Moses' chivalry and offered his daughter's hand in marriage. Moses eventually returned to Egypt, but it's easy to imagine that this beautiful place stayed with him.

The Haddaj Well is an outstanding example of ancient engineering. It reportedly dates back to the Babylonian presence during the 6th century BC, and at 18m across is one of the largest historic wells in the world. It was filled in when the town was abandoned in the 5th century BC, and was said to have been uncovered by a local Jewish man, Suleiman Al Gonaim. The current wheels and pulleys date from improvements made by King Saud in the 1950s.

#### 14:00-14:30 PM

#### Al Naslaa rock

Located 50 km south of the Tayma Oasis in Saudi Arabia is a landform known as the Al Naslaa rock. which features a large chunk of sandstone. The rocks sit on two small natural pedestals measuring 6 meters high and 9 meters wide. The rock sculpture features a lot of bizarre characteristics, which remain a mystery until today. First, the rock is divided in the middle by a perfectly straight gap which seemed impossible to be done by ancient humans. The way the rocks are connected to the pedestals also appears to be floating in perfect balance. Moreover, the side of the rock facing southeast is filled with numerous petroglyphs or rock engraving which depicts Arabian horses, humans, and ibexes. These petroglyphs are thought to be at least 4,000 years old, suggesting the presence of human inhabitants who thrived during the Bronze Age.




## ABHA

At an altitude of 2,200 m between the peaks of the Sarawat Mountains, Abha, is ideally located in southwestern region of Saudi Arabia. Its exceptional location allows you to embrace the clouds and wonder around its mountaintops. While consumed with astonishment and amusement, you will feel like time traveling hundreds of years back in time as you stumble upon castles and palaces built from the elements taken from their unspoiled environment.

Making your way through the fog, even in summertime, you will easily find its plains and cliffs and its rich diversity. You will get a chance to learn closely about the artistic community, and how, hundreds of years ago, women extracted the bright colors from trees and stones to redecorate the spaces and embellish their houses with, a type of abstract art, traditional Qatt Al Aseeri, which is now recognized as a global symbol that expresses man and place.

In Abha, you can enjoy listening to old tales, as you wander around ancient houses that date back to hundreds of years ago. These have been turned into museums by their owners and made available for the world to experience. During your tour, you can have a taste of the past by the diverse selection of traditional dishes offered by museum owners as a rich sensory experience to top your visit. Make sure to get souvenirs engraved with Al-Qatt Al-Aseeri art, which is listed by UNESCO in 2017 on its list of intangible cultural heritage, before you leave. This way, you will leave with Abha deeply engraved in your memory.

In Abha, art played a prominent role in the lives of Aseer women. They looked at the nature of the region and the rigid voids in the walls of their homes and were inspired to explore abstract art by extracting the colors from nature and transforming them into bright patterns known as "Al Qatt Al Aseeri Art," which UNESCO has classified as an intangible Saudi cultural heritage in 2017.

Among the joyful coincidences of fate, the name of the most famous visial artist who contributed to highlighting the art of Al-Qatt Al-Aseeri and passing it on to other women was Fatima Ali Abu Qahas, followed by a student with the same first name, Fatima Yafea, owner of the Fatima Heritage Museum or the Al-Qatt Al-Aseeri Museum.






